He joined the Future Farmers of America and his project was raising and selling orchids. In 1980 he moved to the Mainland and swore off orchids altogether but his "Orchid Fever" returned. He started collecting until his home was filled with upwards of 6,000 plants, causing him to lease a green house space. His collection grew and orchids soon filled his 3,000 sq.ft. greenhouse at Half Moon Bay.

Dennis is an accredited AOS judge and has been President of several Bay Area Orchid Societies and still belongs to 14 societies. He offers assistance whenever possible. While he is here on Kauai he will talk to us about pests and diseases and will have a question-and-answer period.

There will be no orchids 101 and the meeting will start at 6:30 at the Hanapepe United Church of Christ.
