Earning Makana Points

Members sometimes ask how they can earn Makana points. The answer is simple ~ join the Board, serve on a committee, or volunteer at one or more of the Society's events during the year.

Makana points are awarded for the following categories: Officer (President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer) 45 points, Board Member 42 points, Chairperson 36 points or co-chairs 18 points, Spring or Fall Show work shift 5-14 points, and Committee Helpers 7 points. Other points are awarded by the Board and Makana chair as members volunteer for other tasks.
