

2025 Membership Dues




Members must be present at the Holiday Party to redeem their Makana points. 2024 Makana points do not roll over to 2025.



Preparing Your Vandas for the Spring Show Mark Edlund

Having grown and shown orchids for over twenty years, Mark shared with us some tips on preparing





General Preparation



First, vandas should be placed and grown with their body facing south. This encourages the spikes to grow and blooms to open optimally for display and showing.

As spikes develop, stake them in a mostly upright position before any blossoms open to prevent damage to the flowers. Affix the spike to the stake with garden tape.

Stakes can be easily made from a firm wire, like ceiling wire hangers, and should be wrapped with black or dark green tape. Wrapping them "hides" the stakes better for judging which emphasizes the vanda and its flowers.

Rubbing Vaseline around the bottom of the vanda stalk helps prevent ants from traveling up the orchid. Sprinkle cinnamon after making any cuts or trimming leaves. It is an anti-bacterial and also discourages insects.

Fertilize your vandas every two weeks to encourage growth and flower development. Once blossomed, the flowers should last 4 to 6 weeks.

Pre-Show Preparation

If your vanda is hung with a wire hanger, remove the hanger.

Remove all insects and dead material from the vanda. Gently clean the leaves with a mild soap and water mixture. Take care around the spike and any blooms.



Soak the roots in water for 5-10 minutes until they are pliable. Gently wind the roots to fit in the display basket or pot of your choice. Fill in the pot with your choice of medium to secure the vanda in place and firmly hold the stake(s).

For travel to the show, gently separate blooms with cotton balls to keep them from brushing against each other.

Be sure to remove the cotton balls and any other packing material before placing your vanda on the display table.

Be proud that your vanda will display well and maybe even win an award.

After the Show

Carefully re-pack and take your vanda home. Enjoy the flowers for as long as they last. When the flowers are gone, rehang your vanda if it was hung and return it to its permanent location.
